We've experienced heartbreaking tragedy within our Neve Michael family, when our beloved nurse, Ora, received the devastating news that both her husband, and his father, had been burned alive by the Hamas. Neve Michael has rallied around her with an outpouring of love and compassion, especially from our children.

In the face of adversity, we remain unyielding, standing shoulder to shoulder as a family and as a community. We have weathered hardships before, and we will overcome these challenges with the same resilience and strength that have carried us throughout our history.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude for your unwavering emotional and financial support and for being a pillar of strength for Neve Michael's children.


